traethau a morfa heli o bwysigrwyd rhwngwladol sy'n darparu
mannau bwydo pwysig i adar y gwylpdir.

Cors Fochno: un o'r enghreifftiau mwyaf a gorau o gyforgors
fawn ym Mhrydain.


Welcome to Ynyslas Dunes – part of the Dyfi National Nature Reserve (NNR)

This huge reserve covers an area of over
2,000 hectares, and is made up of three very
different areas:

Ynyslas Dunes: the largest dunes in Ceredigion and by far
the most visited. The sandy slopes and hollows provide homes
for a myriad of small animals including rare spiders, mining
bees and spectacular butterflies like dark green fritillaries.

Dyfi Estuary: with vast areas of internationally important
mudflats, sandbanks and saltmarsh that provide important
feeding areas for wetland birds.

Cors Fochno (Borth Bog): one of the largest and finest
remaining examples of a raised peat bog in Britain.

- Cadwch eich cŵn dan reolaeth a defnyddiwr ym binau baw cŵn. (gweler y map)
- Dim gwersylla dros nos neu ddefnyddio cartrefi modur ar y warchodfa
- Peidiwch â chynnau tân yn y twyni
- Dim lansio cychod

IN CASE OF AN EMERGENCY

Call 999. You can find emergency phones:

- Outside the Visitor Centre, opposite the toilets
- At the car park side of north point
- On the shingle ridge at the south end of the dunes

HAZARDS

(please see RNLI beach safety signs)

- Unexploded bombs or shells. Don't touch any suspicious objects, report immediately to the coastguard - ring 999

FOR EVERYONE TO ENJOY

- Please keep dogs under control and use the dog waste bins provided (see map)
- No overnight camping or use of motorhomes on the reserve
- Do not light fires within the dunes
- No launching boats
